EURAXESS Georgia

EURAXESS - Researchers in Motion is a unique pan-European initiative delivering information and support services to professional researchers. Backed by the European Union, member states and associated countries, it supports researcher mobility and career development, while enhancing scientific collaboration between Europe and the world.

The mission of the EURAXESS Network is to facilitate building a common European labour market of researchers by providing free information services, as well as timely and high-quality support to facilitate the relocation and career development of researchers in Europe. The EURAXESS initiative serves as an implementation tool, translating European Research Area (ERA) policies into everyday working practice.

In 2019 Georgia became a member of EURAXESS network, so if you are a researcher planning the next stage of your career EURAXESS Georgia team can provide you with assistance to relocate in Georgia.

EURAXESS Georgia provides information and assistance to researchers and their families on mobility issues and career development opportunities. It also allows universities and researchoriented institutions to attract talents, partners and funding.

EURAXESS Georgia is a platform for researchers, entrepreneurs, universities and businesses to engage with each other. The goal of EURAXESS Georgia is to operate in harmony with all other national networks, facilitate barrier-free movement of knowledge within Europe. EURAXESS Georgia provides information and assistance by all means of this portal and with support of our national Service Centre to researchers who are coming to work in Georgia, as well as to researchers who are leaving for a foreign country.

The Georgian Network consists of National Bridge Head Organisation (BHO), EURAXESS Service Centre (ESC) and EURAXESS Contact Points (ECP) at 6 leading universities.

The National BHO and the ESC are based at the Shota Rustaveli National Science Foundation of Georgia, a Legal Entity of Public Law under the aegis of the Ministry of Education and Science of Georgia.

Georgian Research Landscape

Georgia is a partner country in the European Neighborhood Policy (ENP) and also included in the Eastern Partnership (EaP). Georgia has been associated to Horizon 2020 since 2016. The association of Georgia with Horizon 2020 was an important milestone in the field of research and innovation cooperation with the EU.

In 2018, the Policy Support Facility (PSF) provided specific support to Georgia in three focus areas: identification of promising research fields, developing a proposal for the performance-based funding of research entities, and suggesting measures for narrowing the gap between research and industry/business. Georgia is committed to reform its research and innovation system and the Georgian research and innovation system has undergone considerable restructuring in recent years.

There are several research-oriented organizations in the country. The majority of research institutions including those formerly acted under the umbrella of the Georgian National Academy of Sciences, are merged into 6 leading public universities, some of them are conglomerated as a state military scientific-technical center "Delta", and the others represent standalone research organizations. Also, several think-tanks and national labs are among research performers. The research institutions are largely concentrated in Tbilisi - the capital of Georgia.

Research Funding at a national level

The Shota Rustaveli National Science Foundation of Georgia (SRNSFG) is a Legal Entity of Public Law under the aegis of the Ministry of Education and Science of Georgia, which supports the development of Science, Technology and Innovation (STI) system in Georgia. The vision and strategy of the foundation is in line with Georgia's socio-economic development strategy - «Georgia 2020», the four point governmental reform plan and the EU-Georgia Association Agreement requirements regarding the STI system development.

Foundation is designed to ensure the rational spending of financial means, intended for the science, making the unified science financing system and establishing public trust as well as monitoring stakeholders' activities of State Scientific grants and introducing the report to the Ministry about new scientific products and expected economic effects on data, based on the grant financing.

The foundation implements grant calls, targeted programmes and projects, and is involved in international scientific networks and joint projects. SRNSFG administers more than 20 national and bilateral programmes. SRNSFG funds all the scientific fields in accordance with EUROSTAT and OECD classification.

Competition provides grant funding to conduct:
